### **OUT OF BOUNDS (Rule 27-1)**

- Beyond all perimeter fencing
- Beyond any line of white stakes

### Western Nine

- to the left of Holes no. 1, 5, 6, 7 and 9.
- to the left and right of Holes no. 2 and 3.
- to the right of Hole no. 4.

#### Southern Nine

- to the left of Hole No. 1. near the maintenance area to the right of Holes no. 4, 5 and 6.

to the left of Holes no. 2, 3 and 4.

### WATER HAZARDS (Rule 26)

Yellow stakes -

Water hazards

Red stakes

Lateral water hazards

## **IMMOVABLE OBSTRUCTION (Rule 24-2)**

- Young trees identified by stakes
- Stakes supporting trees
- Halfway huts including the surrounding drains
- Hazards stakes
- Sprinkler heads and irrigation boxes
- Buggy tracks and surrounding drains
- Pump houses, light posts and boxes
- Concrete manholes

### **MOVABLE OBSTRUCTION (Rule 24-1)**

- Stone in bunkers
- Distance markers
- Yellow chains or ropes in the course

### **INTERGRAL PART OF THE COURSE (Rule 28)**

Wooden or concrete support at the margin of some water hazards

### EMBEDDED BALL THROUGH THE GREEN

Through the green, a ball which is embedded in its own pitch mark in the ground, other than sand, maybe lifted without penalty, cleaned and dropped as near as possible to where it lay but not nearer the hole. The ball when dropped must first strike a part of the course through the green.

### **GROUND UNDER REPAIR (GUR) (Rule 25)**


- All areas bounded by white lines
- All green netting on the ground


# **BUNKERS**

Ball comes to rest in a "wash out" area (damaged by storm or rainfall) may be lifted and dropped within the bunker, not nearer to the hole.

### **DROP ZONES**

Drop zones are provided at Southern Nine Holes no. 1, 7 and 8 which is indicated by yellow tee markers. Penalty of one stroke shall be incurred when playing off the drop zone.
